## Our High Care Facility

Braemar House our highly skilled staff care for our residents under the guidance of a Registered Nurse, 24 hours a day.

Our residents have access to a comprehensive activities and therapy program designed to meet the physical, spiritual, cultural and social needs.

We also have a dementia specific unit that is purpose designed with extensive secure outdoor areas and a therapy program designed to meet the needs of our residents.

## Our Low Care Facilities

In our low care facilities we provide support for individuals who require assistance with their activities of daily living on a daily basis. A visiting Registered Nurse is available for clinical care and specialised treatments in a limited capacity.

We encourage our residents to enjoy an active social life with opportunities to maintain their connection with the wider community, family and friends. Lifestyle choices are encouraged and supported through inclusive therapy and activities program. Exercise programs designed specifically for individual residents assist residents to improve their quality of life.

## Respite Care

Respite care is available at our three facilities. Respite provides an opportunity for those individuals who are still at home to have a planned break in a residential care facility. Respite care can assist an individual to stay at home longer by providing an opportunity for the home carer to have a planned break. While in Respite care residents have access to the full range of services. Respite is Government subsidised and in high demand so those requiring this service are encouraged to book in advance to avoid disappointment. Periods between two and nine weeks can be reserved.

## What is Dementia?

Dementia is a general term describing the symptoms experienced by people who have a progressive loss of brain function. It is caused by conditions like stroke, Alzheimer's disease, multiple strokes, alcohol and drug-related brain damage among many other rare conditions.

All conditions causing dementia result in brain cells dying faster than normal. This may drastically change the way a person thinks and behaves. Loss of memory, scrambled thinking and uncharacteristic personality and behaviour changes are typical signs of dementia.

People affected by dementia can't help the way they act and need our support. Braemar House hosts a support group for families of those residents living with dementia.



## Independent Living

Braemar Gardens is an Independent Living complex offering one and two bedroom units designed for independent living in a supportive environment.

For married couples, retirement is required for one partner. Residents furnish their own unit as they wish. Carports are available for residents with cars.
